MEETING OF THE POLICE SERVICE COMMISSION
20 FEBRUARY 2025 @ 12:30 P.M.

At this meeting the PSC:

- Was briefed by Commissioner Kurt Walton on talent development for senior RCIPS roles, and noted the temporary secondment of Detective Superintendent Lansdown as Acting Commissioner of Police in St Helena.
- Agreed the RCIPS policy for acting appointments to roles of superintendent and above, and approved several temporary acting appointments in this category.
- Noted UK Overseas Territories Police Adviser Andrew Munday's appreciation of RCIPS and Cayman Islands Government's commitment to support security work across the overseas territories. Mr. Munday also noted the outstanding facilities and team at the RCIPS ballistics hub, firing range, and Digital Forensics Hub.
- Was introduced to Justice Programme Manager for the Overseas Territories and Polar Department (OTPD) Mr. Patrick Thompson.
- Noted RCIPS' staff engagement levels were good and, in many areas, received awards from the Deputy Governor.
