At this meeting the PSC:

- Noted positive engagement with the Cayman Government on RCIPS resourcing through the recent SPS process.
- Noted the Coast Guard and the Regiment now both fall under the Office of the Commissioner of Police.
- Noted the RCIPS crime statistics continue to reinforce Cayman's reputation as the safest territory in the region.
- Heard a presentation by the Commissioner of Police on succession planning for senior ranks including the requirement to recruit for a new Deputy Commissioner of Police due to upcoming retirement of incumbent.
- Noted that the National Security Council has ratified the PSC approval of the extension of two Superintendents.
- Noted the 2025 civil service engagement survey engagement scores for RCIPS and commended its fair approach to change management.
- Noted appreciation from FCDO for permitting RCIPS officers to cover gaps in other British Overseas Territories.
- Noted the next Meeting date is set for 23 March 2026.
